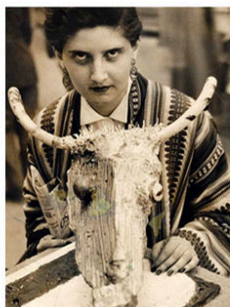

SOSHANA



On 11.01. At 7 pm a very **renowned art historian from Vienna Prof. Dr. Martina Pippal will give a lecture on Austrian artist Soshana.**

Soshana was born in Vienna in 1927 and was forced to leave her motherland as a child to escape the Nazi regime because of her Jewish origin. Soshana's stylistic path gradually led from the objective social realism of her early years to abstraction, calligraphy miniature graphics as well as to colorful, bright paintings. Soshana mingled both in the Parisian circles of the European avant-garde and in the New York artist and intellectual milieu. She was familiar with Picasso, Giacometti, Albert Schweitzer, Arnold Schönberg and countless other prominent personalities of her time. Tireless travelled Soshana the world, creating pictures in Cuba, Japan, China, India, Africa, Italy, Mexico, Southeast Asia, the Caribbean and Israel.

In 2009 the artist Soshana was honored with the Vienna State Golden Medal of Merits. Next year she was given the Grand Cross of Honor for Science and Art.

After the lecture a **documentary film** (won the "silver dolphin" at the Corporate Media & TV Awards in Cannes in 2014) about Soshana's life "Everywhere alone. The artist Soshana" will be held.
